Care providers can claim government funding to cover their training costs by engaging with the Adult Social Care Workforce Data Set (ASC-WDS). Formerly known as NMDS-SC, this service enables care organisations, large and small, to use their data effectively in workforce planning and reporting. Once records have been populated to the required standard, then care providers can become eligible for Workforce Development Fund monies to cover the cost of training.
